

## DEPOSIT OF YOUR PENSION IN 2018

You will find on your notice of deposit the following information:

- The amount of your pension, given on the line “RENTES”
- If applicable, the federal and provincial tax deducted at source
- The amount that will be deposited in your bank account. This is given on the line “SALAIRE NET”

## SUPPLEMENTARY TAX DEDUCTIONS AT SOURCE

You must inform us of all desired changes that may lead to an increase in your tax deductions at source. In such a case, you must send us the following forms:

### - Source Deductions Return (TP-1017 – provincial)

You may obtain this form by going to a Revenu Québec office or online at [revenuquebec.ca](http://revenuquebec.ca).

### - Personal Tax Credits Return (TD1 – federal)

You may obtain this form by going to a Canada Revenue Agency office or online at [cra.arc.gc.ca](http://cra.arc.gc.ca).

Please note that when there is a death, all transactions made in the deceased's account are usually suspended until the estate is settled. To avoid this inconvenience, we strongly recommend that your pension be deposited in a personal bank account that is not a joint account.

## DIRECT DEPOSIT OF YOUR PENSION

### Simple, fast, efficient, and safe!

Payment by direct deposit may make your life much easier. To register, simply visit the "Direct deposit" section of your online file on the CCQ's website, [ccq.org](http://ccq.org).

When you have registered for direct deposit, if you are receiving any other payments or claims from the CCQ, they will also be automatically transferred into the same bank account.

Your payment statements will be accessible electronically in your online file. Your annual pension deposit statement will continue to be sent to you by mail.

**People residing outside of Canada are not eligible for the direct deposit service.**

**Surviving spouses who receive a pension are eligible for the direct deposit service, but may not subscribe to the CCQ's online services.**

## PAYMENT BY CHEQUE

Are you receiving payment of your pension by cheque? Don't forget to notify the Commission de la construction du Québec when you move, because **payment of your pension will stop if there is an incorrect address in your file.**
